Project Description

Centennial is currently working in Boulder to design drainageway improvements, flood mitigation measures, and develop a multi-use path along Elmer's Twomile Creek from Goose Creek to Glenwood Drive.

The project requires new roadway and drainage structures, path design, environmental and cultural resources coordination and mitigation, public involvement, surveys and right-of-way acquisition.

Due to a confined drainageway and bordering highdensity residential and commercial properties, this project requires close coordination between many disciplines and demonstrates Centennial's ability to respond to the client's desire to accommodate the adjacent property owners through public process. Project design is underway and within budget.
